ZOOM SPEAKER CHECKLIST v2

- 1. As a zoom speaker, you should be able to do the following:
 - a. Turn off and on your video.
 - b. Mute and unmute your audio.
 - c. Know how to use the chat function, both privately and to everyone.
 - d. Know how to share your screen.
 - e. Keep track of the amount of time that you have for your part in the event.
 - f. Join the zoom session 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time.
- 2. If you have any links that you wish to be communicated to the audience via the youtube chat, please provide to us at least 2 days before the event.
- 3. Ensure that your name displayed in your zoom window contains your first and last name. You need to do this before you join the zoom session.
- 4. Ensure that you have lighting that faces you so that your face is well lit. Do not have windows or light sources behind you.
- 5. Remember to mute your youtube livestream before you join the zoom session.
- 6. When you join the zoom session, you will be placed in a waiting room. A person that we call the wrangler will communicate with you at this point. The wrangler will look after moving you from the waiting room into the live zoom session.
- 7. IMPORTANT: the youtube live stream of this event will be time delayed from what you will experience in the live zoom session. This delay may be 30 seconds or more.
